Mr. Pranov Vishnu Arjun, Assistant Professor, Government Law College, Coimbatore served as the Resource Person and spoke on the topic "The Need of Human Rights for Women". The Resource Person enlightened the students on the need of human rights for women which enables them to safeguard themselves in the modern world. Women are entitled to enjoy the same human rights and fundamental freedoms as other individuals. International human rights treaties require State parties to take proactive steps to ensure that women's human rights are respected by law and to eliminate discrimination, inequalities, and practices that negatively affect women's rights. Under international human rights law, women may also be entitled to specific additional rights such as those concerning reproductive healthcare. As a particularly vulnerable group, women have special status and protection within the United Nations and regional human rights systems. International human rights treaties prohibit discrimination on the basis of gender and also require States to ensure the protection and realization of women's rights in all areas – from property ownership and freedom from violence, to equal access to education and participation in government. **35 students were benefitted through this session.**


