MAINTENANCE

Maintenance is an important factor in Quality Assurance and efficient functioning of the institution.

POLICY:

- 1. To ensure a clean green and hygienic campus.
- 2. To maintain stability and cleanliness of buildings including class rooms, laboratories, halls, auditoriums, playgrounds and garden.
- 3. To maintain all equipment, computers, electrical and electronic products in an efficient working condition.

PROCEDURES:

- 1. The College has a maintenance supervisor to oversee maintenance activities.
- **2.** Signing periodical contract with security service providers for providing security in the campus.
- **3.** Allotment of support staff is done by the maintenance supervisor for all the various blocks in the campus.
- 4. Specialized laboratory equipment maintenance is outsourced.
- 5. Maintenance of Library books is done continually.
- 6. Stock verification is done annually.
- 7. AMC to be signed periodically for all computers.
- **8.** Maintenance of sports facilities such as courts and ground are done by the assistant marker and support staff.
- 9. Maintenance contract to be renewed for gym equipment periodically.
- 10. Cleaning and sweeping of classrooms and campus is done on a daily basis.
- **11.** Fire extinguishers are kept at focal points for the safety of the inmates

4.	Whitewash of all buildings	- once in 5 years
