STUDENT'S AID FUND

Student Aid Fund aims to improve the welfare of the students by helping and assisting those who find difficulty to pursue studies due to financial problems in the Institution and is contributed by all the members of the staff annually and amount generated is given to needy ones.

POLICY

- 1. To instil strong faith among the students that the Management and teaching faculty are ready to extend financial support in educating the needy ones.
- 2. To ensure in students the confidence that inspite of the financial crisis they can also continue and complete their course in the college.
- 3. To promote and abide by the college emblem, *Knowledge Purifies* and *Charity Enchances*.

PRACTICES

- 1. The objective of the fund is to render financial assistance to extremely poor students to meet partially their tuition fee or examination fee.
- 2. The fund is managed by (a)Principal (b)Management (c)Members of the staff (d) students of the college.
- 3. The teaching faculty of the college generously contribute every year to the needy students to aid their studies throughout their course of study.
- 4. Every year a gradual increase in the amount is given to the students.
- 5. The selection procedures are:
 - i. The Heads of the department will choose one needy student from each class to fill the given application form duly signed by the Heads and submit to the committee.
 - ii. The committee normally meets once in a year in the month of December and Sr.Principal disburse the aid to the students.

OUTCOMES:

- 1. Students are completely benefitted by this mode of financial assistance.
- 2. A great sense of fulfilment is attained by all members of the college in helping a needy student who feels secure by this benefit for her study .
