- 4 The events are intended not only to expand their knowledge in the respective field and associated science, but also to impart a cultural value as well as an obligation towards the society they live in.
- 5 The members of the club solely bear the responsibility to provide their expertise and guidance to the students to transmit powerful and creative messages through film.
- 6 The members of the club also put a great deal of effort in setting up the necessary equipment (lights, amplifiers, speakers etc.) which make the screening process a pleasurable experience.

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- 7 The concept is to get students and others interested in collective film watching with friends and peers.
- 8 The Movie Club includes staff and student representatives across batches (from the 1st year to the 3rd year) who are involved in making the process of movie screening an entertaining one.
- 9 Workshops are arranged to train the students to make documentary movies.
